who have indicated to us, that *Jannes Nijhuis, aged sixty, * born in the municipality of Weerselo, son of Jan Nijhuis and Fenne Lette, builders in the municipality of Weerselo, deceased husband of Geertrui Wenderink, spinner living in Borne*

residing in *Borne* died *today* at *eight* o'clock *before noon* in the house located *in Borne* No. *73*

As a result of this statement we have drawn up this Deed, which, after being read, was signed by us and *the witnesses*.
