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and.....*Dik, Wilhelmina Maria*,
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aged *twenty-seven* years, *shopkeeper*,
born *in Emmen* and residing in
Almelo, adult daughter of Dik, Bernard Wilhelm, deceased, and of Klöne, Maria
Angela, aged fifty-two years, without profession, living in Almelo.
The father of the groom, as well as the mother of the bride, both hereby present,
declare to consent to this marriage
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The proclamation of this marriage took place here *and at*
Borne on the twelfth of June.
..... laatst.

I have asked the future spouses whether they will accept each other as spouses
and faithfully perform the duties attached to the state of marriage by law. These
questions having been answered in the affirmative by them, I have declared, in the
name of the law, that they are bound to each other by marriage.

The witnesses present were: *Pragt, Johan Herman, aged sixty-four years,*
without profession, stepfather of the bride, and Fikkert, Hendrik, aged twenty-eight
years, grocer, brother-in-law of the bride, both living in Almelo.
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Duly noted, which has been read out in accordance with the law.
